The Capital Region's tourism sector employs more than 52,600. Spanning from Catskills to the Adirondacks, the region is packed with recreational and cultural destinations. The region includes more than 420 hotels and other accommodation establishments that employ more than 8,400. No other economic region in the state, except the New York City region, has more accommodation employer establishments, and the Mid-Hudson region is the only upstate region with more accommodation jobs. In 2019, the Glens Falls metro area has one of the nation's highest densities of full-services restaurants, with there being 230 restaurants for every 100,000 people, compared to the US average of 174 per 100,000.


